WHEREAS, at the Administrative Board of District Judges meeting held on October 7, 2015, the District Judges agreed that any petition for expunction, petition for non-disclosure, or petition to seal case, be excepted from the requirement that all civil cases filed by and through an attorney be filed electronically:


WHEREAS, the District Judges agreed that whether a petition for expunction, petition for non-disclosure, or a petition to seal case, is filed by a *Pro Se* individual or by and through an attorney, said petition may be filed in person, by hand, and in paper."

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the filing of a petition for expunction, petition for non-disclosure, or a petition to seal case, shall be excepted from the requirement that all civil cases filed by and through an attorney be filed electronically."


