On the 6th day of August, 2021, a Board of Judges meeting was convened for the District and County Court at Law judges of Montgomery County, Texas. District Judges Gilbert, Michalk, Maginnis, Santini, and Bays attended in person. District Judge Hamilton attended via video-conference during the COVID-19 State of Disaster. County Court at Law Judges Laird and Tucker attended in person. County Court at Law Judges Stewart, Turner, and Watson attended via video-conference during the COVID-19 State of Disaster. The following item was on the agenda: "Eminent Domain/Condemnation Cases." The purpose of the agenda item was that the July 2, 2020 "AMENDED ORDER OF CASE ASSIGNMENT – CIVIL AND FAMILY (NEW AND PENDING CASES)" omitted mention of assignment of eminent domain/condemnation cases. Judges Laird, Santini, and Bays agreed to split the assignment of these cases into thirds among the three of them as the civil judges. During this meeting, Judge Michalk made a motion which was seconded by Judge Tucker that eminent domain/condemnation cases be assigned equally to the 284th and 457th District Courts and County Court at Law Number Two (2). After discussion, a vote was held on said motion. All District and County Court at Law judges in attendance voted in favor of the motion, which carried unanimously.

As such, pursuant to the Texas Government Code, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective on this day, the Montgomery County District Clerk's office shall assign newly filed eminent domain/condemnation cases to courts as follows:

- 1/3 to the 284th District Court;
- 1/3 to the 457th District Court; and
- 1/3 to County Court at Law Number Two (2).




