NO CHEWING GUM USED BY THE WITNESSES WHILE ON THE WITNESS STAND OR BY ANY ATTORNEYS WHILE INTERROGATING THE WITNESS OR ADDRESSING THE COURT

NO NOISES OR TALKING, WHICH INTERFERES WITH THE COURT PROCEEDINGS

NO PROPPING OF FEET ON TABLES OR CHAIRS

NO PHOTOGRAPHS OR RECORDINGS WILL BE MADE IN THE COURTROOM AND NO RECORDING DEVICES, CAMERAS, OR MOVIE CAMERAS WILL BE BROUGHT INTO THE COURTROOM WITHOUT FIRST OBTAINING PERMISSION FROM THE COURT
