



ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NUMBER 2023-01

ORDER RESCINDING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NUMBER 2018-02

Pursuant to TEXAS GOV'T CODE §74.092, the County Criminal Court at Law Judges of Harris County, Texas agreed on May 4, 2018 that all defendants charged with committing the offense of prostitution where it is also alleged that they have been convicted once before of prostitution shall have their cases assigned to Harris County Criminal Court at Law No. 7. The 2018 order was entered to facilitate a specialty court referred to as "SAFE Court." Presently, "SAFE Court" is no longer an available specialty court.

Accordingly, the Judges of the County Criminal Courts at Law **ORDER** that Administrative Order Number 2018-02 be rescinded allowing all cases charging a defendant with a second offense of prostitution to be randomly assigned to any Harris County Criminal Court at Law at the time of filing.

The Judges of the County Criminal Courts at Law further **ORDER** the District Clerk of Harris County, Texas to file a copy of this order in the Administrative Files of these Courts.
