**STANDING ORDER OF CASE ASSIGNMENT RELATING TO POST-JUDGMENT
FILINGS**

Pursuant to Local Rules of the District Courts and Local Rules of the County Courts at Law of Montgomery County, Texas this Order accommodates for the transfer of closed civil cases originally assigned to courts no longer designated as civil courts upon the filing of a related garnishment case of a post-judgment motion, application, or petition, including but not limited to a Bill of Review proceeding on or after August 1, 2023.

Pursuant to the Texas Government Code, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective August 1, 2023, upon filing of a garnishment case, bill of review, or similar, the clerk shall automatically and simultaneously change the judicial officer of both the garnishment case, bill of review, or similar and the related closed civil case if filed in any court no longer receiving new civil filings to the next civil judge in rotation pursuant to the current standing orders for the allocation of newly filed civil cases. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the civil judicial officer shall sit for the court which no longer receives new civil filings in such cases, and may transfer the case to its own court once jurisdiction has attached in the court where the matter was originally filed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, effective August 1, 2023, upon the filing of any post-judgment motion, petition, or application in a case filed in any court no longer receiving new civil filings the clerk shall automatically and simultaneously change the judicial officer of said closed case to a civil court as if the case were newly filed pursuant to current standing orders for the allocation of newly filed civil cases. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the civil judicial officer shall sit for the court which no longer receives new civil filings in such cases, and may transfer the case to its own

court once jurisdiction has attached in the court where the matter was originally filed.

It is ORDERED that the County and District Clerks shall process the applicable judicial officer changes with no further order being necessary. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the above order does not apply when a request is made for copies from the file, unless the filed was in County Court at Law #2 and the request is made on or after 10/1/2023.
