- ALL RESETS SHALL BE EFILED WITH THE DISTRICT CLERK'S OFFICE WITH NOTICE GIVEN TO THE FORT BEND COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE.
- The Reset provided below is to be used for ALL Electronic Resets. Please download to your P.C. before entering the required information.
- Electronic Resets are being accepted on all pending cases with scheduled court appearances. <u>All resets must be submitted by 9:00 a.m. the day of, but no more than 3 days prior to, docket call</u>. It is the attorney's responsibility to get their Client's Signature OR Sign by Permission (W/ NOTICE TO CLIENT). THIS INCLUDES CLIENTS IN CUSTODY. All cases not timely submitted will be subject to bond forfeiture.
- You will need to contact the District Attorney's Office at 281-341-4460 to have any pleas
  worked out before court and to notify them of any essential hearings. Defendants will
  appear in person. Paperwork must be e-filed 48 hours in advance and notice given to
  the Court Coordinator and Prosecutors. Please note that all hearings will be done via
  Webex, unless deemed essential by the court for an in-person hearing.
- <u>IF AN INTERPRETER IS NEEDED</u>, please let the Court know at least one week in advance.
