**Order Requiring Citation by Posting for Small Estate Affidavits**

On this the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of October 2023, the Court finds that there is need for an administrative order regarding notice to all parties interested in an estate when an affidavit is filed for Collection of Small Estates Upon Affidavit under Texas Estates Code § 205. Although the Estates Code does not expressly provide for citation in these cases, § 51.001(b) of the Estates Code provides that the Court may, in its discretion, require that notice be given and may prescribe the form and manner of service and return thereof.

The Court finds that creditors and other interested parties should have an opportunity for notice when an affidavit is filed for Collection of Small Estates Upon Affidavit.

It is therefore **ORDERED** that upon the filing of an affidavit for Collection of Small Estates Upon Affidavit under Texas Estates Code § 205, the Clerk shall require citation to all parties interested in the estate by posting under § 51.053 of the Texas Estates Code.
