ORDER DESIGNATING THE 336TH DISTRICT COURT, THE FANNIN COUNTY COURT AT LAW AND THE FANNIN COUNTY COURT AS JUVENILE COURTS AS WELL AS ASSIGNING DUTIES BETWEEN THE COURTS

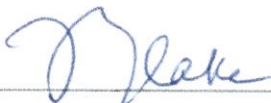
In an effort to increase court time for the handling and administration of juvenile court cases, the Fannin County Court at Law and Fannin County Court are hereby designated, in addition to the 336th Judicial District Court, as Juvenile Courts. The County Court Judge, while serving as a Juvenile Court, will serve in a capacity as back up to the District Court and County Court at Law.

Matters to be heard by the County Court at Law will include, but are not limited to juvenile detention hearings, compliance with conditions of release and or conditions of probation, adjudication hearings, pretrial and jury trial hearings and related matters.

The District Court will continue to appoint counsel on all juvenile matters, make determinations as to attorneys who serve on the Juvenile Appointment Wheel, payment of attorney fee vouchers related to juvenile matters and other such matters as they arise. Nothing in this Order impacts the District Court's ability to concurrently participate in the handling and resolution of juvenile matters with the County Court at Law.

This Order reflects the agreements of the Judges of each of the three courts set forth in this order and is effective immediately.

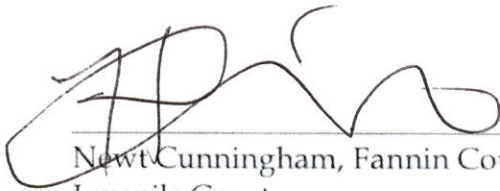
