



**STANDING ORDER OF BRAZORIA COUNTY DISTRICT COURTS**  
**ON JUROR DECORUM AND ATTIRE**

Persons reporting for jury duty in Brazoria County, Texas shall be dressed in clothing appropriate to the dignity and solemnity of court proceedings. General jury panel members shall not wear shorts, crop tops, tank tops, flip-flops, or any other clothing not considered appropriate courtroom attire. In the event a person in a jury panel violates this Order, the person is ordered to stand adjourned from jury service until a subsequent date in the term. The District Clerk is authorized to, and will per Texas Government Code section 62.015, make arrangements for persons in violation of this Order to appear for jury duty at a future date in the term.
