
WHEREAS on November 1, 2022 this court filed and published as required by law, a local rule authorizing the 212th District Court to implement a digital court recorder for live transcription of court proceedings;

WHEREAS on January 2, 2023 this local rule became effective when the requirement to submit local rules to the Texas Supreme Court for Approval was no longer necessary. Commencing January 2, 2023, the court implemented a digital court recording system.

Whereas, on January 2, 2023 this court designated and has used without written order Verbatim Reporting and Transcription, LLC as the official Court Reporter for the 212th Judicial District Court, for the preparation of certified transcripts of proceedings in the 212th Judicial District Court, as needed.

Today, November 10, 2023 this court memorializes in writing and ratifies the designation of an Official Court Reporter effective January 2, 2023.
