WHEREAS, Tex. Gov't Code Sec. 125.003 provides that a mental health court program may handle all issues under Articles 16.22 and 17.032, Code of Criminal Procedure, and Chapter 46B Code of Criminal Procedure;

WHEREAS, the undersigned Judge of the 56th District Court granted authority on November 18, 2021 to the Galveston County mental health court program for any and all issues arising under Article 17.032, Code of Criminal Procedure for cases within the jurisdiction of the 56th District Court;

WHEREAS, in order to more efficiently manage the docket of the 56th District Court and avoid conflicts in scheduling of the attorneys assigned to the cases;

THEREFORE, by the authority of the Judge of the 56th District Court, THE ABOVE REFERENCED ORDER DATED NOVEMBER 18, 2021 IS HEREBY RESCINDED for the 56th District Court effective immediately. Henceforth, all bond hearings within the jurisdiction of the 56th District Court will be heard by the Judge of the 56th District Court (or his designee).
