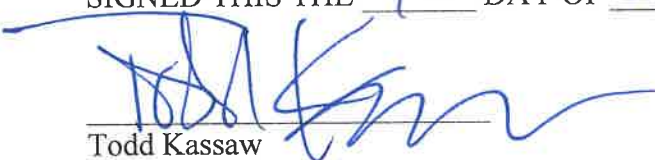
Our records reflect that this cause does in fact affect the parent-child relationship and the cause currently before this Court was filed on the _____ day of _____, 20____.

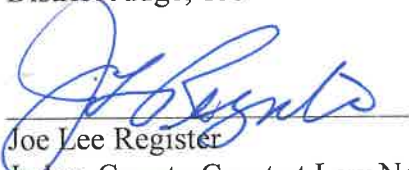
All parties in the above styled and numbered cause are hereby **ORDERED** to attend and successfully complete the seminar.

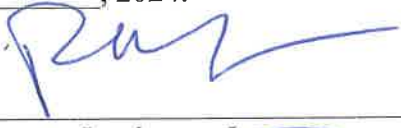

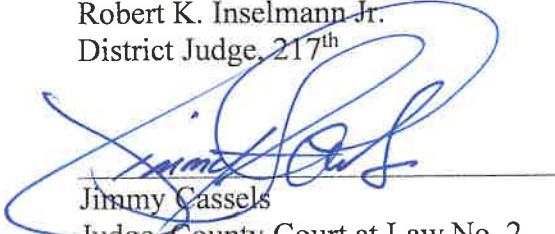
