COURT'S STANDING OMNIBUS ORDER ON DISCOVERY

The Court hereby authorizes the State of Texas, in all cases pending in the Court, to release the following records to counsel for the defense without the necessity of a formal presentation of a motion to release the following records:

- MEDICAL RECORDS
- GRAND JURY RECORDS
- DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY AND PROTECTIVE SERVICES RECORDS
- CRIMINAL HISTORIES


The Court expressly grants to the State of Texas permission to withhold releasing evidence in all the categories listed above if the State of Texas requests a formal hearing on these discovery issues.

The Court further ORDERS that counsel for the defense in all cases are prohibited from:

1. Disclosing documents that contain certain protected information to any other person or entity;
2. Using or disclosing records that contain protected information for any purpose other than for litigation and proceedings connected to the case and may not disclose or use these documents for any other reason.

Upon the conclusion of the trial or the proceedings in the case, counsel for the Defendant is ORDERED to return or destroy he disclosed documents pursuant to this Order.
