ORDERED that:

1. For each Application for Temporary Guardianship case (TEC Chapter 1251) filed after the effective date of this order, the Clerk of Johnson County Courts at Law No. 1 and No. 2 is directed to collect a deposit from the filing attorney in the amount of \$750.00. This deposit is in addition to all other fees required for the filing of such cases. This deposit shall be retained by the clerk for the payment of the statutorily required Attorney Ad Litem (Texas Estates Code Section 1251.004).
2. The Attorney Ad Litem appointed in such cases shall file with the Clerk an application for payment of the fee deposit with supporting verification of fees incurred in the representation of the proposed Ward. After review and approval by the Judge of the applicable Court, the Clerk will pay the Attorney Ad Litem the deposit amount.
3. The effective date of this order is December 6, 2023.
