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**AMENDED STANDING ORDER REGARDING TRAVEL WHILE  
UNDER PRE-TRIAL SUPERVISION**

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Bexar County Court at Law #2 hereby issues the following Standing Order:

Individuals under Pre-Trial Supervision shall have the right to travel outside of Bexar County and the State of Texas without having to request permission from the Court. Defendants shall have this right unless it has been specifically prohibited by the Court. Individuals traveling must notify their Pre-Trial Officer at least 48 hours prior to travel and must submit a UA within 24 hours of return.

Individuals on Full or Partial House Arrest, Tracking, or Curfew must stay in Bexar County unless authorized by the Court. However, a Pre-Trial Supervision officer shall permit their attendance at the following events without having to request permission from the Court, provided that such attendance is not in violation of any no-contact orders, can be verified, and is within 75 miles of Bexar County:

1. Funeral and funeral-related services of an immediate family member
2. Physician appointments
3. Attorney-Client meetings with the attorney of record
4. Hospital or emergency clinic visits in cases of a medical emergency
5. Appointments with Pre-Trial Services and the Re-Entry Center
