

NOTICE TO ALL LITIGANTS WHO PARTICIPATE IN TITLE IV-D COURT MATTERS (i.e. Attorney General Cases) in Calhoun County, Texas

Notice is hereby given that unless you have waived the right (either in writing or on the record), you have the right to a **De Novo Hearing Before the Referring Court** regarding any decision made by the IV-D Court Associate Judge. Tex. Fam. Code §201.012

Any party may request a **De Novo Hearing Before the Referring Court**, regarding the Associate Judge's decision or ruling, by filing with the Clerk of the referring Court a written request not later than the third (3rd) working day after the date the party receives notice of the substance of the Associate Judge's report as provided by Tex. Fam. Code §201.011 or the rendering of a temporary order, if the request concerns a temporary order rendered by an associate judge under section 201.007 (a)(14) (c). Tex. Fam. Code §201.015 (a).

A request for a **De Novo Hearing Before the Referring Court** must be in writing and must specify the issues that will be presented to the referring court. Tex. Fam. Code §201.015(a) & 201.015 (b).

Notice of a request for a **De Novo Hearing Before the Referring Court** shall be given to the Clerk of the Referring Court and to all other attorneys and parties. Tex. Fam. Code §201.015(d).
