ADDENDUM TO THE LOCAL RULE FOR THE 82ND JUDICIAL DISTRICT—ROBERTSON COUNTY

WHEREAS; the District Court has been mandated by the Texas Legislature to maintain a 90% disposition rate of all pending criminal cases and;

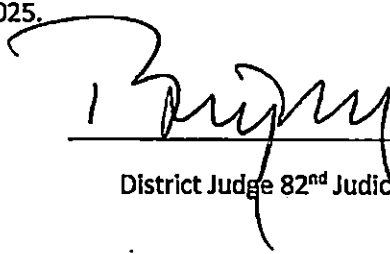
WHEREAS; failure of the District Court may result in the implementation of judicial sanction by either the Texas Supreme Court or the Office of Court Administration and;

Whereas; this local rule addendum is intended to streamline the trial process and to provide an effective and efficient way to process cases to a conclusion.

THEREFORE EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2025 THE FOLLOWING RULES SHALL APPLY IN ALL CRIMINAL CASES IN ROBERTSON COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. The Court shall determine the order in which cases shall be presented for jury trial;
2. If a defendant has more than one pending case the Court will order which case shall proceed to trial;
3. A pretrial conference will be held no less than 60 days before trial. The pretrial conference is mandatory and will be held on the record. At the pretrial conference the Court will take up any pretrial matters except Motions in Limine. All modifications to indictments, if any, shall be done prior to the pretrial conference. In the event a defendant has multiple cases, the Court will order which case or cases shall proceed to trial. Any notices of enhancement shall be done at or before the pretrial.
4. All requests for continuances shall be filed no later than 30 days before trial. Any motion for continuance filed within 30 days of trial will not be considered by the Court unless there is an emergency. (the unavailability of an expert witness or fact witness will not be considered an emergency.)
5. All discovery shall be delivered or made available to the attorney for the defendant prior to the pretrial.
