COURT'S STANDING OMNIBUS ORDER ON DISCOVERY

The Court hereby authorizes the State of Texas, in all cases pending in this Court, to release the following records to the counsel for the defense without the necessity of a formal presentation of a motion to release the records:

MEDICAL RECORDS

GRAND JURY RECORDS (INCLUDING GRAND JURY TESTIMONY)

DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY AND PROTECTIVE SERVICES RECORDS

CRIMINAL HISTORIES

JUVENILE RECORDS (IF PREVIOUSLY RELEASED BY THE PRESIDING JUVENILE JUDGE)

PRIOR JUROR SERVICE

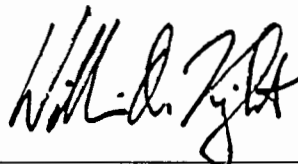
The Court expressly grants to the State of Texas permission to withhold releasing evidence in these categories listed above if the State of Texas requests a formal hearing on these discovery issues.

The Court further ORDERS that counsel for defense in all cases are prohibited from:

1. Disclosing documents that contain certain protected information to any other person or entity;
2. Using or disclosing records that contain protected information for any purpose other than for litigation and proceedings connected to the case and may not disclose or use these documents for any other reason.

Upon conclusion of the trial or proceedings in the case, counsel for the defendant is ORDERED to return or destroy the documents disclosed pursuant to this order.
