**GENERAL STANDING ORDER CLARIFYING
PROTECTIVE ORDER APPLICATION CASE ASSIGNMENTS**

1. *Sua sponte*, the District Courts in Bowie County and the County Court at Law issue the following ORDER for clarification of the Local Rules already in effect.

2. Local Rules 3.1.3 and 3.1.4 provide for the assignment of Family Cases to the District Courts and relates to assignment and transfer of Texas Department of Family Protective Services matters to the County Court at Law and District Courts.

3. **Rule 3.1.4 (d)** is hereby adopted by the District and County Court at Law Courts in Bowie County to provide the following:

All Applications for Protective Order made pursuant to the Texas Family Code and presented to the District Clerk for filing shall be filed into and assigned to the County Court at Law of Bowie County, unless a different filing and assignment is mandated pursuant to Tex. Fam. Code Chapters 81 through 88.

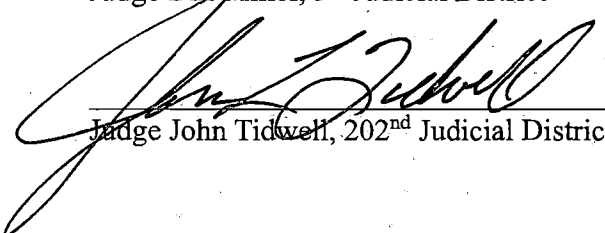

IT IS SO ORDERED.

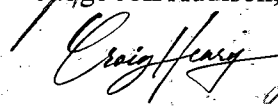
