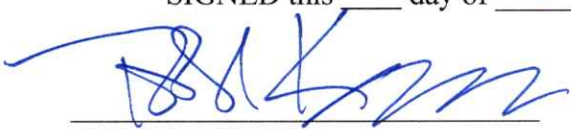
ORDER GRANTING STATE'S MOTION FOR ALTERNATIVE SERVICE
(ARTICLE 59 TEXAS CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CASES)

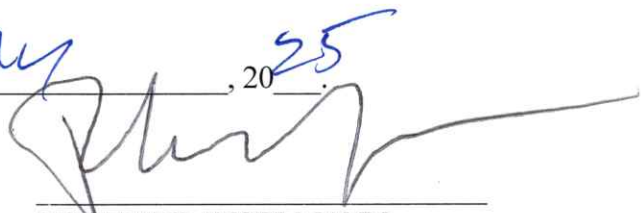
On the 16th day of July, 2025, the State's Motion for Alternative Service was heard by the Court. After considering the motion and the sworn affidavit of Petitioner, the Court finds that the motion should be GRANTED.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the following persons, if 18 years of age or older, are authorized to serve process or citations in civil cases filed by the State of Texas, by and through the District Attorney of Angelina County, if such cases seek asset seizure or forfeiture under Chapter 59 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure. The following persons must not be a party to or have an interest in the outcome of the individual suit, and must meet the following requirements for authorization to serve citations in these cases:

1. Serve as a law enforcement officer for the police departments of the cities of Lufkin, Diboll, Huntington, or for the Texas Department of Public Safety;
2. Serve as a law enforcement officer or jailer employed by the Angelina County Sheriff's Department;
3. Serve as an Investigator with the District or County Attorney's Office;
4. Serve as a Court Bailiff or Security Officer for the Angelina County District Courts, County Courts, County-Court-at Law Courts, or Justice of the Peace Courts.
