

**STANDING ORDER OF ADMINISTRATION
REGARDING EMINENT DOMAIN CASES**

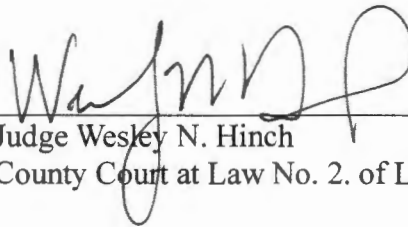
The Judges of the County Court at Law (No.1) of Liberty County and County Court at Law No. 2. of Liberty County, to: (1) achieve a fair and equitable division of caseloads between the two Courts; (2) improve and facilitate the administration and management of the court system; (3) implement a strategy for managing cases that require special judicial attention, have adopted the following Standing Order of Administration:

All eminent domain cases filed with the Liberty County Clerk shall be assigned and docketed in and with the County Court at Law (No.1) of Liberty County; to be heard, handled, docketed and administered through to disposition and other related matters, or subsequent transfer or other order of the Court.
