3rd Amended STANDING ORDER ON SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF BOND FOR SELECT CASES IN COUNTY COURT AT LAW NO. 2

This Amended Standing Order of Judge Melissa Saenz, Presiding Judge of Bexar County Court at Law No. 2, is requesting that all Magistrates and/or Associate Judges and Pre-Trial Services, impose, at a minimum, the below bond conditions for individuals **arrested on or after January 9, 2026**, who are assigned to Bexar County Court at Law No. 2 and charged with:

- Driving While Intoxicated;
- Assault Bodily Injury;
- Evading Arrest or Detention;
- Prostitution;
- Possession of Marijuana; **OR**
- Possession of Controlled Substance

The bond conditions requested are:

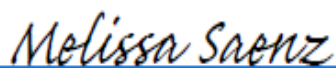
- No Drugs or Alcohol;
- A Chemical Dependency Screening with a Licensed Counselor;
- Compliance with the Screening Recommendation; **AND**
- Regular Monthly UA's with Pre-Trial Services (UA fees waived);

This request is not meant as a substitute for the Magistrate and/or Associate Judges independent assessment of reasonable conditions. Article 17.15(a) and Article 17.40 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure allow for conditions to be placed that relate to the safety of the community. Judge Saenz is requesting the above conditions be imposed to reduce recidivism and address any possible substance related issues that may exist for the Defendant closer in time to their arrest. The above misdemeanor offenses have been selected by Judge Saenz due to their tendency to be related to drugs or alcohol which pose a greater risk of harm to the community.

*Please note all substance screenings are free and are at no financial cost to the Defendant. Additionally, any recommended counseling from the screening is also free and at no financial cost to the Defendant.

It is ORDERED that this order be filed with the Bexar County Clerk.
