STANDING ORDER REGARDING SCHEDULING OF PRETRIAL HEARINGS FOR
DEFENDANTS WITH PENDING FELONY CHARGES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the County Court at Law of Hays County, Texas, and in the interest of judicial efficiency and coordination with felony proceedings in the District Courts, Hays County Court at Law No. 1 issues the following order.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. In all criminal cases filed in Hays County Court at Law No. 1, following the defendant's arraignment, if the defendant has a pending felony charge in any jurisdiction, Pretrial Hearing No. 1 in the misdemeanor case shall not be scheduled sooner than six (6) months (24 weeks) after the date of arraignment.
2. This Order shall apply regardless of whether the pending felony is in the same county or in another Texas jurisdiction, provided the pending felony is confirmed by court records or representations of counsel.
3. The Court may, upon motion and good cause shown, schedule a hearing sooner than the six-month period at the discretion of the presiding judge.
4. This Order shall apply to all criminal cases currently pending and to all future cases filed on or after the effective date of this Order.

THIS HAYS COUNTY STANDING ORDER REGARDING SCHEDULING OF PRETRIAL HEARINGS FOR DEFENDANTS WITH PENDING FELONY CHARGES SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON PUBLICATION ON THE OFFICE OF COURT ADMINISTRATION'S WEBSITE.
