**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING ASSIGNMENT OF JUDGES
FOR EMERGENCY MATTERS**

Pursuant to Tex. Gov't Code §74.092, the local administrative judges for Taylor County make the following judicial assignments for emergency matters, specifically for the hearing of emergency applications for search warrants to obtain specimens of blood from persons whom law enforcement has probable cause to believe have committed, or are committing, the crime of driving while intoxicated.

July 2026 – Judge Jeff Propst, 104th District Court
August 2026 – Judge Thomas Wheeler, 350th District Court
September 2026 – Judge Robert Harper, County Court at Law No. 1
October 2026 – Judge Harriett Haag, County Court at Law No. 2
November 2026 – Judge Arimy Beasley, 42nd District Court
December 2026 – Judge Jeff Propst, 104th District Court

These judges are assigned and must be available for law enforcement 24 hours a day during the months for which they are assigned. If judges wish to swap months by agreement, they must notify the local administrative judges.
