

IN THE COUNTY COURTS AT LAW OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY, TEXAS STANDING ORDER OF CASE ASSIGNMENT – NEW CIVIL CASES

Pursuant to Local Rules of the County Courts at Law of Montgomery County, Texas this order redirects the filing and allocation of civil cases within the jurisdiction of the County Courts at Law of Montgomery County, Texas, on or after September 1, 2022.

Pursuant to the Texas Government Code, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective September 1, 2022 the Montgomery County County Clerk's office shall assign newly filed civil cases as follows:

- 1. All civil cases shall be assigned to County Court at Law 6, except the following:
 - a. Administrative law review cases (ALR Appeals Texas Transportation Code §524.041)
 - i. 100% to County Court at Law 5
 - b. All civil cases related to a probate case
 - i. 100% to County Court at Law 2
 - c. Occupational license request
 - i. Assigned to the court where the applicant has a criminal case pending or to County Court at Law 2 if no criminal case pending
 - d. All civil cases related to an associated criminal case
 - i. Assigned to the court where the applicant has a criminal case pending

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any and all portions of the assignment of civil cases filed with the County Clerk's Office are hereby AMENDED as outlined above and this shall amend any prior local rule of the County Courts at Law for Montgomery County, Texas to the extent it they may conflict with any such prior local rule.
