**ORDER REGARDING MAGISTRATE'S ORDERS FOR EMERGENCY PROTECTION**

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of May, 2013, a Board of Judges meeting was convened for the District and County Court at Law judges of Montgomery County, Texas. District Judges Wood, Hamilton and Gilbert attended. District Judges Case, Michalk, Mayes and Seiler were absent. County Court at Law Judges Watson, Laird, McDonald, Turner and Stewart attended. No County Court at Law Judges were absent. The following item was on the agenda: "Court Assignment of Emergency Magistrate's Orders." During this meeting, District Judge Hamilton made a motion, which was seconded by County Court at Law Judge Laird, that all Magistrate's Orders for Emergency Protection be issued from the court to which the criminal act giving rise to the issuance of the emergency order for protection is assigned. After discussion, a vote was held on said motion. All District and County Court at Law judges in attendance voted in favor of the motion. As such, the motion carried unanimously.

As such, pursuant to the Texas Government Code, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, effective immediately, that all Magistrate's Orders for Emergency Protection be issued from the court to which the criminal act giving rise to the issuance of the emergency order for protection is assigned.
