

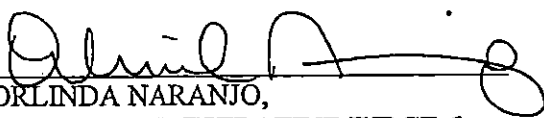
CRIMINAL CASES PENDING TRANSFER PROCEDURE

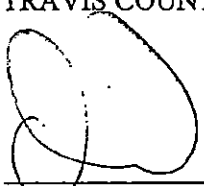
On February 11, 2005, the County Courts at Law Judges, in a collaborative effort adopted the following procedure to handle the transfer of criminal cases currently pending in Travis County Courts at Law No. 1 and No. 2, which primarily handle civil cases to the County Courts at Law that handle the criminal matters.

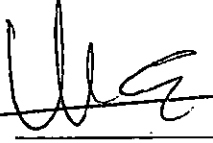
- Any pending active criminal cases in County Court at Law #1 and County Court at Law No. 2 will be reassigned in rotation in the County Courts at Law No. 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7.
- Except that any cause where there is a pending case in another court is reassigned to the pending court.

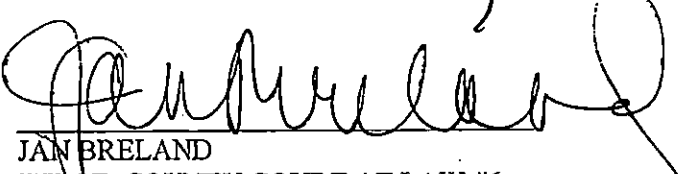

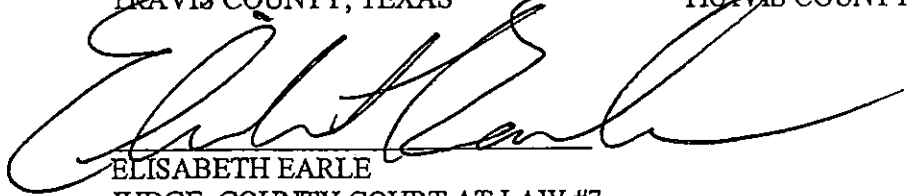
