ORDER

Whereas, upon an arrest for a Felony offense, a defendant is required to appear before a Magistrate for the purpose of arraignment and setting of bond; and

Whereas, the Magistrate, after consideration of the factors set forth in Article 17.15 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, sets the bond amount and determines bond conditions, if any; and

Whereas, upon Indictment of the Defendant, the case is set on the District Court Docket;

It is therefore ORDERED that, the bond amount and conditions set by the Magistrate will remain in full force and effect after Indictment and through trial or disposition, subject only to an amendment by the District Court after notice and hearing;

In accordance therewith, the District Clerk is ORDERED upon receipt of the Indictment to place the Magistrate's order setting bond and setting bond conditions in the court's file for all cases in which a Magistrate's Order has been signed.
