
**STANDING ORDER ON WARRANTS OF ARREST AND BONDS ON MOTIONS
TO REVOKE OR ADJUDICATE COMMUNITY SUPERVISION**

The undersigned district judges of Travis County, Texas pursuant to V.T.C.A. Government Code § 24.003, do hereby order that a warrant of arrest on a Travis County District Court motion to revoke community supervision or motion to proceed to an adjudication of guilt on a deferred adjudication community supervision may be ordered by any of the undersigned judges acting for a district judge to which the case is assigned, and may set a bond and sign a personal bond or cash deposit bond to release a defendant, acting for the district judge to which the case is assigned. A warrant of arrest in such matters may also be ordered, and a bond set or personal bond or cash deposit bond signed by the Travis County Criminal Law Magistrate (district court magistrate) and by any visiting judge assigned to one of the judges' courts or Travis County Criminal Law Magistrate court. In so doing, the judge or magistrate is acting for and as the surrogate for the judge of the court to which the case is assigned and in ordering such an arrest does not become "the judge who ordered the arrest for the alleged violation" for purposes of Art. 42.12, Section 21(b-1), Texas Code of Criminal Procedure. No other judge or magistrate of any other court may set a bond, or sign a personal bond or cash deposit bond regarding a Travis County District Court motion to revoke community supervision



or a motion to proceed to an adjudication of guilt on a deferred adjudication community supervision.






