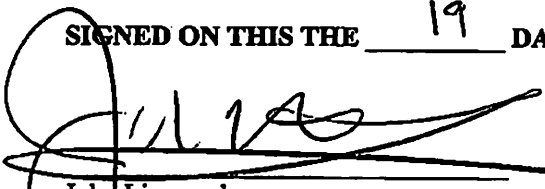
ORDER

The Court, *sua sponte*, has determined that, in those instances where a defendant is reported deceased by notice of their driving record from DPS, and where that defendant has an outstanding warrant after sentence, the notice of reported deceased from DPS is sufficient proof to determine death. The interest of justice demands that the said misdemeanor Capias or Motion to Revoke Warrant be recalled and any outstanding balances of fines and/or costs related thereto should be waived and the disposition recorded as satisfied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that upon notification that defendant is reported deceased, the County Clerk shall recall the outstanding misdemeanor Capias or Motion to Revoke warrant, waive the outstanding balances of fine and/or costs related thereto, and close the case as referenced in the aforementioned paragraph.

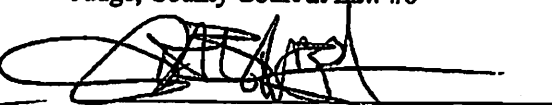
