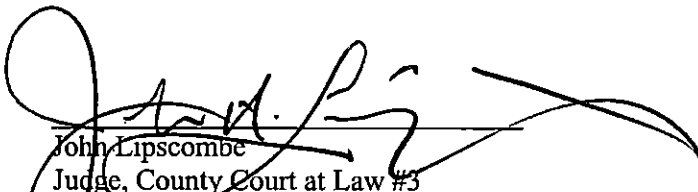
ORDER

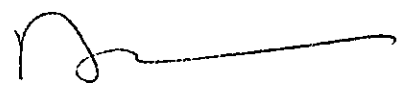
The Court, *sua sponte*, has determined that, in those instances where a defendant has been sentenced to regular jail time and/or SWAP on a misdemeanor charge and all jail time has been satisfied and only fines and/or costs are due and the defendant would have previously been allowed to spend time in custody to satisfy their monies due and the current practice would call for costs to be concurrent, the interest of justice demands that the misdemeanor warrant be recalled and balances waived.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that upon notification that defendant has satisfied jail time owed, the County Clerk shall recall the outstanding misdemeanor Capias and waive the outstanding balances of fine and/or costs related thereto.

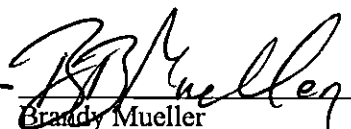
